Written Testimony in Support of SR 1805

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee:

During last year's legislative session our organization came before you in support of 3-Feet passing legislation for bicycles. We thank you for your support in the successful passing of this legislation.

Once again we come before you; this time is support of SR 1805. We would like to see the time come when the livable/complete street concept is the rule and not the exception.
