Senate Subcommittee Instructions for FY 2013

- (1) Subcommittees will begin on January 31. Some meetings will take place on Fridays. The Ways and Means meeting time on Thursdays may be made available for Subcommittee work.
- (2) Subcommittee meeting dates, times and room assignments will be completed by the Chairman's Chief of Staff (COS). Each meeting's workload will be coordinated between the COS, Subcommittee Chair, and associated Fiscal Analyst(s). It is the responsibility of the Subcommittee Chair's Office Assistant to create and submit agendas to the Senate Calendar. Any changes to the schedule must be run through the COS in consultation with the fiscal staff and all subcommittee members.
- (3) Room availability is very limited. If room size is a concern, please contact the COS to see if a larger room can be found. If there is a room change, notify fiscal staff, subcommittee members, and the COS. Make sure to have your assistant post the change.
- (4) Subcommittee decisions are to be completed by the close of the final subcommittee meeting to allow Fiscal and Revisor's staff appropriate time to complete the subcommittee report prior to the full committee's consideration. If there are difficulties in completing the report on time, the COS must be consulted at the earliest possible time to determine whether schedule adjustments can be made.
- (5) The Revisor's Office is available to assist with legal issues during subcommittee meetings. Please contact Jill, Daniel, or David to make necessary arrangements.

Fiscal instructions

- (6) FY 2013 is going to be another extremely tough budget. No one will be completely satisfied, but if we all work together, it can help the process be less painful. Each subcommittee must recommend funding <u>at or below</u> the Governor's recommendation. Money can be moved around within the entities under the subcommittee's jurisdiction.
- (7) Find ideas of overspending or opportunities for savings. Closely scrutinize transfers between funds and figures such as population numbers, clients served and other estimates in each agency. In addition, examine the FTE count and budgeted shrinkage for each agency. Consider permanently cutting unfilled positions. Inquire about required annual report. Electronic copies should be encouraged.
- (8) At the Chair's discretion, more global issues may have to be dealt with by full committee.

Bottom line—build a budget within existing resources. Complete your work in subcommittees since very few items will be considered at omnibus and even at that, only with the permission of the Chair. Remember—there is always a possibility of not having an omnibus. Additional money may not be present at that time and additional cuts may be required depending on how revenue continues to come in compared with revenue estimates.
