James Roller, Chesapeake, (<u>Attachment 1</u>) spoke to the committee about Kansas' unconventional oil and natural gas production and the use of hydraulic fracturing to extract this energy source. He noted that Aubry McBrenan and Tom Ward were the originators of this company in 1986 with \$50,000 investment. They believe domestic oil and gas is an opportunity to wean the United States off the overseas sources. Mississippi Lime has three kinds of resources that can be extracted with a portion of that find in south central Kansas. The five basic steps for oil and natural gas production are: site selection/preparation, drilling, completing, production and reclamation.
