
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2013 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2013 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law allows importers, manufacturers, dealers, and collectors licensed under the federal gun control act whose place of business is in Kansas, to sell rifles and shotguns to residents of states contiguous to Kansas. It is also lawful for residents of Kansas to purchase these firearms from dealers in contiguous states. HB 2013 would repeal the laws allowing such sales and purchases.

Passage of HB 2013 would have no fiscal effect on the Attorney General's Office or the Judiciary. State sales tax collections would be unaffected as well, according to the Department of Revenue.
