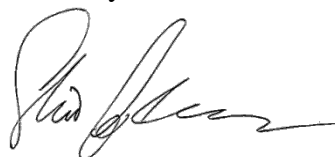
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2058 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2058 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2058 would allow the driver of a motorcycle facing any steady red signal, which fails to change to a green light within a reasonable period of time because of a signal malfunction or because the signal has failed to detect the arrival of the motorcycle because of its size or weight, to proceed after making a stop.

Passage of HB 2058 would have no fiscal effect on the state budget, nor is it expected to have a fiscal effect to county or city budgets.
