
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2060 by Representative Sloan

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2060 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2060 relates to disposition of a military member's remains and would legally recognize the primacy of any decision written by the member of the military on the federal DD Form 93, that would specify the disposition of remains should the military member die during military service. The DD Form 93 lists the military member's emergency data.

The Division of the Budget considers this bill to be a procedural matter and has determined that it would have no fiscal effect on the state or the military.
