
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2061 by Representative Sloan

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2061 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2061 would clarify existing law by adding the rule that a person would be criminally responsible for causing a result if the only difference between what actually occurred and what was intended is that a different person or property was injured, harmed, or affected.

According to the Office of Judicial Administration, enactment of HB 2061 would have no fiscal effect on the Judicial Branch.
