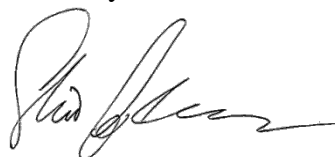
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2069 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2069 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2069 would prohibit a court from admitting statements, activities, waivers of charges for medical care provided, or other conduct expressing regret, mistake, error, sympathy, apology, or compassion which are made by a health care provider or an employee or agent of a health care provider, as evidence of an admission of liability in a civil action.

Both the Health Care Stabilization Fund and the Board of Healing Arts indicate that the passage of HB 2069 would have no fiscal effect on their operations.
