
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2209 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2209 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2209 would prohibit any legislator from holding elected office for a municipality if compensation other than expense reimbursement is given for the other elected office. For purposes of this bill, municipality is defined as county, township, city, school district, community junior college, municipal university, city, county or district hospital, drainage district, cemetery district, fire district, and other political subdivision or taxing unit, and including their boards, bureaus, commissions, committees and other agencies, including but not limited to, library board, park board, recreation commission, and hospital board of trustees.

Enactment of HB 2209 is not anticipated to have any fiscal effect on state government. Whether there are legislators currently holding a second office, who would be affected by the bill is not known.
