
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2267 by House Committee on Energy and Utilities

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2267 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2267 would require the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) to compile a report regarding electric supply and demand for all electric utilities in Kansas. The report would include generation capacity needs, system peak capacity needs and renewable energy generation needs associated with the 2009 Kansas renewable energy standards. The first report would be due on February 1, 2013 and every two years thereafter. The KCC would submit the report to the House Committee on Energy and Utilities and the Senate Utilities Committee.

The Kansas Corporation Commission indicates that any costs resulting from HB 2267 would be negligible.
