SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2286 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2286 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2286 would prohibit districts from receiving supplemental general state aid payments if a district has less than 200 square miles and less than 260 students for the preceding school year, beginning in the 2013-2014 school year.

Based upon current enrollment data, enactment of HB 2286 would reduce supplemental general state aid payments by \$1,787,473, all from the State General Fund, beginning in FY 2014. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2286 is not reflected in *The FY 2012 Governor's Budget Report*.
