
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2391 by House Committee on Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2391 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2391 would require anemometer towers that are located outside municipalities and are at least 50 feet in height to be marked in a way that would allow the towers to be recognized in clean air during daylight hours. Any tower erected before July 1, 2011 must be marked within two years.

Enactment of HB 2391 would have no fiscal effect on state operations.
