SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2566 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2566 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, virtual students are counted in the formula for assessed valuation per pupil for computing a district's capital improvement aid. HB 2566 would exclude the number of virtual students who do not reside in a school district from the computation of a district's capital improvement aid.

According to the Department of Education, enactment of HB 2566 would not change the amount of capital improvement aid to school districts. However, some individual school districts may receive a slight increase in state aid payments, while others may have a slight reduction.
