SUBJECT: Corrected Fiscal Note for HB 2674 by House Committee on Government Efficiency

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following corrected fiscal note concerning HB 2674 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under HB 2674, the Kansas Highway Patrol would no longer have to provide budgeting, purchasing, and related management functions for the Bureau of Emergency Medical Services.

The Bureau of Emergency Medical Services is now known as the Board of Emergency Medical Services. The Board of Emergency Medical Services states there would be no fiscal effect on agency operations from the passage of HB 2674 since the Board is no longer under the Highway Patrol. The Highway Patrol indicates there would be no fiscal effect on agency operations resulting from the passage of HB 2674.
