
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2723 by House Committee on Government Efficiency

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2723 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2723 would require each state agency which uses a commercial printer for promotional advertising services to aid in the performance of the state agency's powers, duties, and functions to obtain such services through competitive bidding. All electronic files used by the commercial printing service provider in printing the state agency's materials would be required to be returned to the state agency from which the electronic material came. The bill would also repeal KSA 74-5033, which granted an exception to the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks, and Tourism regarding bid requirements when the Department contracts for promotional advertising services.

The Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks, and Tourism indicates there would be no fiscal effect on agency operations resulting from the passage of HB 2723.
