
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2734 by House Committee on Education Budget

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2734 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2734 amends current law regarding compulsory school attendance by students turning 16 years of age who have been receiving special education. If a school registration that is provided to the State Board of Education includes an affirmation that school courses are taught by a competent instructor for at least 180 days, attendance at the school for students with disabilities would satisfy state compulsory attendance requirements.

Enactment of HB 2734 would have no fiscal effect.
