SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2759 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2759 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, to be issued a microbrewery license by the Department of Revenue, a person must be a resident of the State of Kansas. HB 2759 would remove this requirement.
