
SUBJECT: Revised Fiscal Note for SB 211 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following revised fiscal note concerning SB 211 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 211 would allow a pharmacist to provide a three-month supply of a legend drug that is not a controlled substance or psychotherapeutic drug when a practitioner has written a prescription that includes a sufficient number of refills for a three-month supply.

Since the original fiscal effect statement was issued, the Board of Pharmacy has provided updated information on the fiscal effect of this bill. The Board of Pharmacy indicates that SB 211 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
