SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 274 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 274 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 274 would authorize the Department of Revenue to issue one temporary permit for a special event as approved by the local governing body of a city, county, or township. The temporary permit would allow the consumption of alcoholic liquor on a street, alley, road, sidewalk, or highway that has been closed to motor vehicle traffic. The temporary permit would be issued for no longer than ten consecutive days.
