SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 356 by Senate Committee on Commerce

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 356 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 356 relates to regulation of home-owned amusement rides. The bill would remove the exemption currently applied to home-owned amusement rides from regulation by the Department of Labor. These rides are defined as those owned by a not-for-profit entity and operated solely within one county, by individuals on a volunteer basis, and for fewer than 12 days within a year.

The Department of Labor does not anticipate the inclusion of these rides to have a sizable effect upon current agency expenditures to regulate amusement rides.
