
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 383 by Senate Committee on Utilities

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 383 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 383 would require each utility company to allow commercial, industrial, school, local government, state government, federal government, agricultural, and institutional customer-generators to generate electricity subject to net metering up to three megawatts. Currently, the limit is 200 kilowatts.

Enactment of SB 383 would have no fiscal effect on the Kansas Corporation Commission.
