
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 400 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 400 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 400 would allow cities to require landlords to provide lists of their tenants if a city had adopted a rental licensing ordinance requiring owners of single family dwellings in residential zoning districts to obtain rental licensing permits prior to renting.

SB 400 would have no fiscal effect on the state and negligible or no fiscal effect on cities.
