
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 415 by Senate Committee on Assessment and Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 415 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 415 would establish a 10.0 percent bid preference for the purchase of vehicles manufactured within the State of Kansas. The bill would apply only to bids which match the exact vehicle specifications of the state agency purchasing the vehicle.

The Department of Administration indicates any fiscal effect resulting from the passage of SB 415 could be absorbed within existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 415 is not reflected in *The FY 2013 Governor's Budget Report*.
