
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 451 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 451 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 451 would allow an individual to affix window tinting to vehicle windows, which exceeds limits established in current law if the individual has a completed medical exemption certificate. The medical exemption certificate would be prepared on a form furnished by the Division of Vehicles of the Kansas Department of Revenue. The certificate must be approved by a medical professional, which is specified in the bill. The certificate would be valid for up to two years. The Director of Vehicles would promulgate rules and regulations to implement SB 451 on or before January 1, 2013.

The Department of Revenue indicates any fiscal effect resulting from the passage of SB 451 could be absorbed within existing agency resources.
