SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 90 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 90 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 90 would allow the Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board to deny, refuse to renew, suspend, revoke, condition, limit, qualify, or restrict the license of any applicant or licensee when an allegation of abuse, neglect, or exploitation has been substantiated by the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services.

The Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board indicates that SB 90 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
