1 AN ACT concerning the legislative educational planning committee;
2 relating to the powers and duties thereof; amending K.S.A. 2010
3 Supp. 46-1208a and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 46-1208a is hereby amended to read
7 as follows: 46-1208a. (a) The legislative educational planning committee
8 is hereby established and shall be composed of 13 members, seven of
9 whom shall be members of the house of representatives and six of whom
10 shall be senators. Members of the legislative educational planning
11 committee shall be appointed by the legislative coordinating council. The
12 legislative coordinating council shall determine the number of members
13 of the committee who shall be members of the majority party and the
14 number of members of the committee who shall be members of the
15 minority party. The committee shall be permanent with membership
16 changing from time to time as the legislative coordinating council shall
17 determine.

18 (b) ~~Except for matters or issues relating to school finance,~~ The
19 legislative educational planning committee shall plan for public and
20 private postsecondary education in Kansas, including vocational and
21 technical education; explore, study and make recommendations
22 concerning preschool and K-12 education in Kansas; review
23 implementation of legislation relating to educational matters; and
24 consider such other matters as the legislative coordinating council may
25 assign. The committee shall annually make a report and recommendations
26 to the legislature and the governor and may cause the same to be
27 published separately from other documents which are required by law to
28 be submitted to the legislative coordinating council. The reports and
29 recommendations of the committee shall include a developmental
30 schedule for implementation of educational goals established by the
31 committee. The committee shall from time to time update such schedule
32 as new or additional information is developed or refined.

33 (c) The provisions of the acts contained in article 12 of chapter 46 of
34 the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, applicable to
35 special committees shall apply to the legislative educational planning
36 committee to the extent that the same do not conflict with the specific

1 provisions of this act applicable to the committee.

2 (d) Upon request of the legislative educational planning committee,
3 the state board of regents and the state board of education shall provide
4 consultants from the faculties and staffs of institutions and agencies under
5 the respective control and jurisdiction thereof.

6 (e) The legislative educational planning committee shall meet upon
7 call of its chairperson and may introduce such legislation as it deems
8 necessary in performing its functions.

9 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 46-1208a is hereby repealed.

10 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
11 publication in the statute book.
