AN ACT concerning the state board of pharmacy, establishing a prescription drug disposal program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this act, "narcotic drug" has the same meaning as prescribed in K.S.A. 65-4101, and amendments thereto.
- (b) The state board of pharmacy shall establish the prescription drug disposal program to accept and dispose of prescription-only drugs provided by persons for disposal purposes. The board shall adopt rules and regulations governing the prescription drug disposal program that establishes standards and procedures for the acceptance and disposal of prescription drugs, which shall include, but not be limited to:
- (1) If a drug is provided by a person pursuant to this act, a pharmacist shall document the name of the drug and the person's name, address and signature.
 - (2) If a narcotic drug is provided by a person pursuant to this act:
- (A) A pharmacist shall document the name of the drug and the person's name, address and signature; and
- (B) a pharmacy employee shall document the number of narcotic drugs provided by the person and the pharmacy employee's signature acknowledging the number of narcotic drugs provided by the person.
- (3) Pharmacists may charge no more than \$5 per donor for the disposal of prescription drugs.
- (c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the pharmacy act of the state of Kansas.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
