1 AN ACT designating a part of K-9 highway as the David Mee memorial
2 highway; amending K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 68-1051 and repealing the
3 existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section. 1. From the junction of United States highway 75 and
7 K-9 highway, then west on K-9 to the junction of K-9 with K-63 is hereby
8 designated as the David Mee memorial highway. The secretary of
9 transportation shall place signs along the highway right-of-way at proper
10 intervals to indicate that the highway is the David Mee memorial highway,
11 except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received
12 sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for
13 the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to
14 defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The
15 secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations
16 to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

17 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 68-1051 is hereby amended to read as
18 follows: 68-1051. The portion of United States highway 75 where it enters
19 the state on the Kansas-Nebraska border on the north then south to the
20 junction with K-9 ~~then west to the junction of K-9 with K-62~~, then south
21 ~~from the junction of K-9 with K-62~~ to the junction of K-62 with K-16 then
22 east to the junction with United States highway 75 then south on United
23 States highway 75 to the southern city limits of Holton, then from the
24 junction of United States highway 75 and N.W. 46th street in Shawnee
25 county then south on United States highway 75 to the Kansas-Oklahoma
26 border, is hereby designated the purple heart/combat wounded veterans
27 highway. The secretary of transportation shall place markers along the
28 highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the
29 purple heart/combat wounded veterans highway. The secretary of
30 transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in
31 obtaining suitable highway signs bearing the proper approved inscription.

32 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 68-1051 is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
34 publication in the statute book.
