1 AN ACT concerning crimes, criminal procedure and punishment; relating
2 to the Kansas alien rapid repatriation act.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) This act shall be known and may be cited as the Kansas
6 criminal alien rapid repatriation act.

7 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the secretary of
8 corrections may conditionally release any prisoner in the secretary's
9 custody to the custody and control of the United States immigration and
10 customs enforcement, provided the secretary has received an order of
11 deportation for such prisoner and such prisoner:

12 (1) Has served at least $\frac{1}{2}$ of the prison portion of the sentence
13 imposed by the court; and

14 (2) is not serving a sentence imposed for a conviction of a person
15 felony.

16 (c) If a prisoner released pursuant to this section returns illegally to
17 the United States, upon notice of such prisoner's incarceration from any
18 federal or state law enforcement agency, the secretary shall revoke the
19 conditional release of such prisoner and such prisoner shall serve the
20 remainder of the sentence imposed by the court. Such prisoner shall not be
21 eligible for probation or conditional release, as provided in this section, on
22 any sentence affected by such release.

23 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
24 publication in the statute book.
