1 AN ACT designating the junction of interstate 70 and United States
2 highway 183 as the CW2 Bryan J. Nichols fallen veterans memorial
3 interchange.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. The junction of interstate 70 and United States highway
7 183 is hereby designated as the CW2 Bryan J. Nichols fallen veterans
8 memorial interchange. The secretary of transportation shall place signs
9 along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the
10 junction of interstate 70 and United States highway 183 is the CW2 Bryan
11 J. Nichols fallen veterans memorial interchange, except that such signs
12 shall not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from
13 gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such
14 signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance
15 or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may
16 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing
17 suitable signs.

18 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
19 publication in the statute book.
