## **HOUSE BILL No. 2656**

AN ACT concerning state government; relating to the transfer of all powers, duties and functions of the adult protective services program of the department of social and rehabilitation services to the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) All of the powers, duties and functions of the department of social and rehabilitation services concerning adult protective services are hereby transferred to and conferred and imposed upon the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas.

- (b) The office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas shall be the successor in every way to the powers, duties and functions of the department of social and rehabilitation services concerning adult protective services in which the same were vested prior to the effective date of this section. Every act performed in exercise of such powers, duties and functions by or under the authority of the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas shall be deemed to have the same force and effect as if performed by the department of social and rehabilitation services, in which such powers, duties and functions were vested prior to the effective date of this section.
- (c) All rules and regulations of the department of social and rehabilitation services concerning adult protective services in existence on the effective date of this section shall continue to be effective and shall be deemed to be duly adopted rules and regulations of the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas until revised, amended, revoked or nullified pursuant to law.
- (d) All orders and directives of the department of social and rehabilitation services concerning adult protective services in existence on the effective date of this section shall continue to be effective and shall be deemed to be orders and directives of the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas until revised, amended or nullified pursuant to law.
- (e) On the effective date of this section, the balances of all funds or accounts thereof appropriated or reappropriated for adult protective services of the department of social and rehabilitation services relating to the powers, duties and functions transferred by this section shall be transferred by the director of accounts and reports to the office of the

 attorney general of the state of Kansas and shall be used only for the purpose for which the appropriation was originally made.

- (f) On the effective date of this section, all officers and employees who, immediately prior to such date, were engaged in the performance of powers, duties and functions of the department of social and rehabilitation services concerning adult protective services which are transferred by this section, or who became part of the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas, or the powers, duties and functions of which are transferred to the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas, and who, in the opinion of the attorney general, are necessary to perform the powers, duties and functions of the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas, shall be transferred to, and shall become officers and employees of the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas. All classified employees so transferred shall retain their status as classified employees. Thereafter, the attorney general may convert vacant classified positions to positions in the unclassified service under the Kansas civil service act.
- (g) Officers and employees of the department of social and rehabilitation services transferred by this section shall retain all retirement benefits and leave balances and rights which had accrued or vested prior to the date of transfer. The service of each such officer and employee so transferred shall be deemed to have been continuous. All transfers, layoffs or abolition of classified service positions under the Kansas civil service act shall be made in accordance with the civil service laws and any rules and regulations adopted thereunder. Nothing in this section shall affect the classified status of any person employed by the department of social and rehabilitation services prior to the date of transfer.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 2013, and its publication in the statute book.
