1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to the issuance of distinctive
2 license plates; amending K.S.A. 8-1,148, 8-1,150 and 8-1,151 and
3 K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,142, 8-1,153, 8-1,158, 8-1,161, 8-1,162 and 8-
4 1,164 and repealing the existing sections.
5

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,142 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 8-1,142. (a) As used in this section, "educational institution"
9 means:

10 (1) Any state educational institution under the control and supervision
11 of the state board of regents;

12 (2) any municipal university;

13 (3) any not-for-profit independent institution of higher education
14 which is accredited by the north central association of colleges and
15 secondary schools accrediting agency based on its requirements as of April
16 1, 1985, is operated independently and not controlled or administered by
17 the state or any agency or subdivision thereof, maintains open enrollment
18 and the main campus or principal place of operation of which is located in
19 Kansas;

20 (4) any community college organized and operating under the laws of
21 this state; and

22 (5) Haskell Indian Nations university.

23 (b) Any owner or lessee of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks
24 registered for a gross weight of not more than 20,000 pounds who is a
25 resident of Kansas, upon compliance with the provisions of this section,
26 may be issued one educational institution license plate for each such
27 passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be issued for the same
28 period of time as other license plates upon proper registration and payment
29 of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
30 thereto, plus the payment of an additional fee of \$5 for each plate, and the
31 presentation of the annual emblem use authorization statement provided
32 for in subsection (c).

33 (c) Any educational institution may authorize through its officially
34 recognized alumni association or foundation the use of such institution's
35 official emblems to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section.
36 Any royalty payment to such alumni association ~~or~~, foundation *or county*

1 *treasurer* derived from this section, except reasonable administrative costs,
2 shall be used for recognition of academic achievement or excellence
3 subject to the approval of the chancellor or president of the educational
4 institution. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may annually apply to the
5 alumni association or foundation for the use of the institution's emblems.
6 Upon annual application and payment to the alumni association ~~or~~,
7 foundation *or county treasurer* in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more
8 than \$100 as an emblem use royalty payment for each educational
9 institution license plate to be issued, the alumni association ~~or~~, foundation
10 *or county treasurer* shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee,
11 without further charge, an emblem use authorization statement, which
12 shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of
13 registration. *Royalty payments collected by the county treasurer shall be*
14 *sent to the educational institution.*

15 (d) Any applicant for an educational institution license plate may
16 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
17 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
18 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for the educational institution
19 license plates shall provide the annual emblem use authorization statement
20 provided for in subsection (c). Application for registration of a passenger
21 vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plates under this section shall
22 be made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of
23 vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

24 (e) No registration or educational institution license plate issued
25 under this section shall be transferable to any other person.

26 (f) *The director of vehicles may transfer educational institution*
27 *license plates from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.*

28 ~~(g)~~ (g) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
29 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (b), in the
30 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
31 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
32 such applicant provides the annual emblem use authorization statement
33 provided for in subsection (c). If such emblem use authorization statement
34 is not presented at the time of registration, *or faxed by the alumni*
35 *association or foundation*, the applicant shall be required to comply with
36 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the educational
37 institution license plates to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

38 ~~(h)~~ (h) The director of vehicles shall not issue any educational
39 institution license plates for any educational institution, unless such
40 educational institution's alumni association or foundation guarantees the
41 initial issuance of at least 500 license plates.

42 ~~(i)~~ (i) The director of vehicles shall discontinue the issuance of an
43 educational institution's license plate authorized under this section if:

1 (1) Less than 500 educational institution license plates, including
2 annual renewals, are issued for an educational institution by the end of the
3 second year of sales; and

4 (2) less than 250 educational institution license plates, including
5 annual renewals, are issued for an educational institution during any
6 subsequent two-year period.

7 (†) (j) Each educational institution's alumni association or foundation
8 shall:

9 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for such educational license
10 plates; and

11 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
12 where applicants can call the alumni association or foundation for
13 information concerning the application process or the status of their
14 license plate application.

15 (†) (k) Each educational institution's alumni association or foundation,
16 with the approval of the director of vehicles and subject to the availability
17 of materials and equipment, shall design a license plate to be issued under
18 the provisions of this section.

19 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1,148 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-1,148.

20 (a) On and after July 1, 1999, any owner or lessee of one or more
21 passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of not more than
22 20,000 pounds who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with the
23 provisions of this section, may be issued one children's trust fund license
24 plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be
25 issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper registration
26 and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and
27 amendments thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use
28 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

29 (b) The advisory committee on children and families established in
30 K.S.A. 38-1901, and amendments thereto, may authorize the use of their
31 logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any royalty
32 payment to such committee *or county treasurer* derived from this section
33 shall be credited to the family and children trust account of the family and
34 children investment fund, established in K.S.A. 38-1808, and amendments
35 thereto, and, shall be used in accordance with the provisions of paragraph
36 (2) of subsection (c) of K.S.A. 38-1808, and amendments thereto. Any
37 motor vehicle owner or lessee may annually apply to the committee for the
38 use of such logo. Upon annual application and payment to the committee
39 *or county treasurer* in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100
40 as a logo use royalty payment for each children's trust fund plate to be
41 issued, the committee shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee,
42 without further charge, a logo use authorization statement, which shall be
43 presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of registration.

1 *Royalty payments collected by the county treasurer pursuant to this*
2 *section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the*
3 *provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of*
4 *each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in*
5 *the state treasury to the credit of the family and children trust account of*
6 *the family and children investment fund, established in K.S.A. 38-1808,*
7 *and amendments thereto.*

8 (c) Any applicant for a children's trust fund license plate may make
9 application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such person's
10 renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by the
11 director of motor vehicles, and any applicant for the children's trust fund
12 license plates shall provide the annual logo use authorization statement
13 provided for in subsection (b). Application for registration of a passenger
14 or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made
15 by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles
16 upon forms furnished by the director.

17 (d) No registration or children's trust fund license plate issued under
18 this section shall be transferable to any other person.

19 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
20 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
21 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
22 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
23 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement
24 provided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
25 not presented at the time of registration, *or faxed by the committee*, the
26 applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
27 thereto, and return the children's trust fund license plate to the county
28 treasurer of such person's residence.

29 (f) The advisory committee on children and families shall:

30 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for such children's trust fund
31 license plates; and

32 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
33 where applicants can call the children's trust fund for information
34 concerning the application process or the status of their license plate
35 application.

36 (g) The advisory committee on children and families, with the
37 approval of the director of vehicles and subject to the availability of
38 materials and equipment, shall design a plate to be issued under the
39 provisions of this section.

40 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 8-1,150 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-1,150.

41 (a) Any owner or lessee of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks
42 registered for a gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of
43 Kansas, upon compliance with the provisions of this section, may be

1 issued one Kansas foundation for agriculture in the classroom license plate
2 for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be
3 issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper registration
4 and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and
5 amendments thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use
6 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

7 (b) The board of directors of the Kansas foundation for agriculture in
8 the classroom may authorize the use of their logo to be affixed on license
9 plates as provided by this section. Any royalty payment received pursuant
10 to this section shall be paid to the foundation *or county treasurer* and shall
11 be used in accordance with the by-laws of the foundation to further the
12 mission of the foundation. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee annually
13 may apply to the board for the use of such logo. Upon annual application
14 and payment to the board *or county treasurer* in an amount of not less than
15 \$25 nor more than \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for each license
16 plate to be issued, the board shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or
17 lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization statement, which
18 shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of
19 registration. *Royalty payments collected by the county treasurer shall be*
20 *sent to the Kansas foundation for agriculture.*

21 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
22 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
23 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
24 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
25 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
26 subsection (b). Application for registration of a passenger vehicle, truck or
27 motorcycle and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be
28 made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of
29 vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

30 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
31 transferable to any other person.

32 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
33 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
34 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
35 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
36 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement
37 provided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
38 not presented at the time of registration, *or faxed by the Kansas foundation*
39 *for agriculture*, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-
40 143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county
41 treasurer of such person's residence.

42 (f) The board of directors of the Kansas foundation for agriculture in
43 the classroom shall:

1 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorized
2 by this section; and

3 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
4 where applicants can call the board for information concerning the
5 application process or the status of their license plate application.

6 (g) The board of directors of the Kansas foundation for agriculture in
7 the classroom, with the approval of the director of vehicles and subject to
8 the availability of materials and equipment, shall design a plate to be
9 issued under the provisions of this section.

10 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 8-1,151 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-1,151.

11 (a) On and after January 1, 2002, any owner or lessee of one or more
12 passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 20,000
13 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with the
14 provisions of this section, may be issued one Ancient Arabic Order, Nobles
15 of the Mystic Shrine of North America (Shriners) license plate for each
16 such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be issued for the
17 same time as other license plates upon proper registration and payment of
18 the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
19 thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use authorization statement
20 provided for in subsection (b).

21 (b) The shrine temple to which the person is a member in good
22 standing may authorize the use of their logo to be affixed on license plates
23 as provided by this section. Any royalty payment received pursuant to this
24 section shall be paid to the shrine temple *or county treasurer* and shall be
25 used to support the shriners hospitals for children. Any motor vehicle
26 owner or lessee annually may apply to the shrine temple for the use of
27 such logo. Upon annual application and payment to the shrine temple *or*
28 *county treasurer* in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 as a
29 logo use royalty payment for each license plate to be issued, the shrine
30 temple shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further
31 charge, a logo use authorization statement, which shall be presented by the
32 motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of registration. *Royalty payments*
33 *collected by the county treasurer shall be sent to the shrine temple to*
34 *which the person is a member.*

35 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
36 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
37 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
38 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
39 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
40 subsection (b). Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck
41 and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the
42 owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon
43 forms furnished by the director.

1 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
2 transferable to any other person.

3 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
4 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
5 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
6 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
7 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement
8 provided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
9 not presented at the time of registration, *or faxed by the shrine temple to*
10 *which the applicant is in good standing*, the applicant shall be required to
11 comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the license
12 plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

13 (f) The shrine temples of Kansas shall:

14 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorized
15 by this section; and

16 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
17 where applicants can call the shrine temples for information concerning
18 the application process or the status of their license plate application.

19 (g) The shrine temples of Kansas, with the approval of the director of
20 vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and equipment, shall
21 design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

22 Sec. 5. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,153 is hereby amended to read as
23 follows: 8-1,153. (a) On and after January 1, 2005, any owner or lessee of
24 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
25 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with
26 the provisions of this section, may be issued one helping schools license
27 plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be
28 issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper registration
29 and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and
30 amendments thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use
31 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

32 (b) The state board of education may authorize the use of the logo to
33 be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any royalty
34 payment received *by the state board of education or the county treasurer*
35 pursuant to this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in
36 accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments
37 thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall
38 deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the helping
39 schools license plate program fund. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee
40 annually may apply to the state board of education for the use of such
41 logo. Upon annual application and payment to the board *or county*
42 *treasurer* in an amount of \$40 as a logo use royalty payment for each
43 license plate to be issued, the board shall issue to the motor vehicle owner

1 or lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization statement, which
2 shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of
3 registration.

4 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
5 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
6 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
7 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
8 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
9 subsection (b). Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck
10 and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the
11 owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon
12 forms furnished by the director. The school district to receive the royalty
13 payment shall be designated by the applicant on such forms.

14 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
15 transferable to any other person.

16 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
17 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
18 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
19 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
20 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement
21 provided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
22 not presented at the time of registration, *or faxed by the state board of*
23 *education*, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-143,
24 and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county
25 treasurer of such person's residence.

26 (f) The helping schools license plate shall not be developed by the
27 division until the state board of education has collected sufficient logo use
28 royalty payments under subsection (b), to comply with the provisions of
29 paragraph (1) of subsection (e) of K.S.A. 8-1,141, and amendments
30 thereto.

31 (g) The state board of education, with the approval of the director of
32 vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and equipment, shall
33 design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

34 Sec. 6. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,158 is hereby amended to read as
35 follows: 8-1,158. (a) On and after January 1, 2008, any owner or lessee of
36 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
37 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with
38 the provisions of this section, may be issued one breast cancer research
39 and outreach license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such
40 license plates shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon
41 proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in
42 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the presentation of the annual
43 logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

1 (b) The university of Kansas cancer center may authorize the use of
2 their logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any
3 royalty payment received pursuant to this section shall be paid to the
4 university of Kansas cancer center *or county treasurer*, and shall be used to
5 support a statewide coordinator for the midwest cancer alliance that serves
6 as a liaison between the university of Kansas cancer center, hospitals,
7 physicians and clinics across the state of Kansas. This statewide
8 coordination includes the provision of assistance to the university of
9 Kansas cancer center statewide medical director in working to ensure that
10 breast cancer patients in communities across Kansas are aware of what
11 prevention and early detection protocols, treatment choices and clinical
12 studies are available to them. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee annually
13 may apply to the university of Kansas cancer center for use of such logo.
14 Upon annual application and payment to the university of Kansas cancer
15 center *or county treasurer* in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than
16 \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be
17 issued, the university of Kansas cancer center shall issue to the motor
18 vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization
19 statement, which shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee
20 at the time of registration. *Royalty payments collected by the county*
21 *treasure shall be sent to the university of Kansas cancer center.*

22 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
23 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
24 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
25 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
26 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
27 subsection (b). Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck
28 and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the
29 owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon
30 forms furnished by the director.

31 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
32 transferable to any other person.

33 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
34 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
35 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
36 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
37 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement
38 provided for in subsection (b). If such statement is not presented at the
39 time of registration, *or faxed by the university of Kansas cancer center*, the
40 applicant shall be required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143,
41 and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county
42 treasurer of such person's residence.

43 (f) The university of Kansas cancer center shall provide to all county

1 treasurers a toll-free telephone number where applicants can call the
2 university of Kansas cancer center for information concerning the
3 application process or the status of such applicant's license plate
4 application.

5 Sec. 7. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,161 is hereby amended to read as
6 follows: 8-1,161. (a) On and after January 1, 2010, any owner or lessee of
7 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
8 not more than 20,000 pounds who is a resident of Kansas, upon
9 compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued one support
10 Kansas arts license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such
11 license plates shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon
12 proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in
13 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the presentation of the annual
14 logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

15 (b) The Kansas arts commission, created under K.S.A. 74-5202, and
16 amendments thereto, may authorize the use of their logo to be affixed on
17 license plates as provided by this section. Any royalty payment to such
18 commission *or county treasurer* derived from this section shall be credited
19 to the Kansas arts commission special gifts fund and, shall be used in
20 accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 74-5204, and amendments
21 thereto. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may annually apply to the
22 commission for the use of such logo. Upon annual application and
23 payment to the commission *or county treasurer* in an amount of not less
24 than \$25 nor more than \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for each
25 license plate to be issued, the commission shall issue to the motor vehicle
26 owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization statement,
27 which shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time
28 of registration.

29 (c) Any applicant for a support Kansas arts license plate may make
30 application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such person's
31 renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by the
32 director of motor vehicles, and any applicant for the support Kansas arts
33 license plates shall provide the annual logo use authorization statement
34 provided for in subsection (b). Application for registration of a passenger
35 vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be
36 made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of
37 vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

38 (d) No registration or support Kansas arts license plate issued under
39 this section shall be transferable to any other person.

40 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
41 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
42 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
43 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until

1 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement
2 provided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
3 not presented at the time of registration, *or faxed by the Kansas arts*
4 *commission*, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-143,
5 and amendments thereto, and return the support Kansas arts license plate
6 to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

7 (f) The Kansas arts commission shall:

8 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for such support Kansas arts
9 license plates; and

10 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
11 where applicants can call the Kansas arts commission for information
12 concerning the application process or the status of their license plate
13 application.

14 (g) The Kansas arts commission, with the approval of the director of
15 vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and equipment, shall
16 design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

17 Sec. 8. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,162 is hereby amended to read as
18 follows: 8-1,162. (a) On and after January 1, 2012, any owner or lessee of
19 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
20 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with
21 the provisions of this section, may be issued one Boy Scouts of America
22 license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. In addition to the
23 license plate, a person issued such a license plate may request a decal for
24 the order of the arrow, wood badge, God and country award and eagle
25 scout for each license plate. Such license plates shall be issued for the
26 same time as other license plates upon proper registration and payment of
27 the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
28 thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use authorization statement
29 provided for in subsection (b).

30 (b) A Boy Scouts of America council may authorize the use of their
31 logo to be affixed on license plates or any decal as provided by this
32 section. Any royalty payment received pursuant to this section shall be
33 paid to the Boy Scouts of America *or county treasurer* and shall be used to
34 support the Boy Scouts of America. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee
35 annually may apply to the Boy Scouts of America for the use of such logo.
36 Upon annual application and payment to the Boy Scouts of America *or*
37 *county treasurer* in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 as a
38 logo use royalty payment for each license plate and decal to be issued, the
39 Boy Scouts of America shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee,
40 without further charge, a logo use authorization statement, which shall be
41 presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of registration.
42 *Royalty payments collected by the county treasurer shall be sent to the Boy*

1 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
2 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such

4 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
5 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
6 subsection (b). Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck
7 and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the

9 forms furnished by the director.

10 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
11 transferable to any other person.

12 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
13 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
14 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
15 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
16 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement
17 provided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
18 not presented at the time of registration, *or faxed by the Boy Scouts of*
19 *America*, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and
20 amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county treasurer of
21 such person's residence.

22 (f) The Boy Scouts of America councils shall:

23 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorized
24 by this section; and

25 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
26 where applicants can call the Boy Scouts of America councils for
27 information concerning the application process or the status of their
28 license plate application.

29 (g) The Boy Scouts of America councils, with the approval of the
30 director of vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and
31 equipment, shall design a plate and decals to be issued under the
32 provisions of this section.

33 (h) A fee of \$2 shall be paid for each decal issued under this section.
34 Such decals shall be affixed to the license plate in the location required by
35 the director.

37 follows: 8-1,164. (a) On and after January 1, 2012, any owner or lessee of
38 one or more passenger vehicles, trucks registered for a gross weight of
39 20,000 pounds or less or motorcycles, who is a resident of Kansas, upon
40 compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued one I'm pet
41 friendly license plate for each such passenger vehicle, truck or motorcycle.
42 Such license plates shall be issued for the same time as other license plates
43 upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided

1 in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the presentation of the
2 annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

3 (b) The college of veterinary medicine at Kansas state university may
4 authorize the use of their I'm pet friendly logo to be affixed on license
5 plates as provided by this section. Any royalty payment received *by the*
6 *college of veterinary medicine at Kansas state university or the county*
7 *treasurer* pursuant to this section shall be paid to the college of veterinary
8 medicine at Kansas state university and shall be used to support education
9 regarding the spaying and neutering of dogs and cats in Kansas and
10 veterinary student externships at animal shelters in Kansas. Any motor
11 vehicle owner or lessee annually may apply to the college of veterinary
12 medicine at Kansas state university for the use of such logo. Upon annual
13 application and payment to the college of veterinary medicine at Kansas
14 state university *or county treasurer* in an amount of not less than \$25 nor
15 more than \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for each license plate to be
16 issued, the college of veterinary medicine at Kansas state university shall
17 issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo
18 use authorization statement, which shall be presented by the motor vehicle
19 owner or lessee at the time of registration.

20 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
21 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
22 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
23 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
24 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
