1 AN ACT concerning board of barbering; relating to fees; amending
2 K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 65-1817 and repealing the existing section.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 65-1817 is hereby amended to read as
6 follows: 65-1817. (a) In each fiscal year, the board shall determine the
7 amount of funds which will be required during the next ensuing fiscal
8 year to properly administer the laws which the board is directed to
9 enforce and administer and shall fix fees in accordance with this section
10 for such ensuing year in such reasonable sums as may be necessary for
11 such purposes.

12 (b) After fixing such fees, the board may charge and collect the fees,
13 in advance for the following purposes, subject to the following
14 limitations:

- 15 For examination of applicant to practice barbering—not more than~~100~~120
- 16 For issuance of license to practice barbering—not more than~~80~~100
- 17 For renewal of license to practice barbering—not more than~~80~~100
- 18 For restoration of expired license to practice barbering, if expiration period is
19 under three years,
20 the lapsed fees plus a restoration fee of not more than..... 100
- 21 After three years applicant shall be reexamined upon payment of the regular
22 examination fee—not more than~~100~~120
- 23 For instructors license or annual renewal thereof—not more than~~90~~130
- 24 For restoration of expired instructors license, if expiration period is under three
25 years, the lapsed fees
26 plus a restoration fee of not more than~~90~~130
- 27 After three years the instructor shall be reexamined upon payment of the regular
28 examination fee—not more than~~170~~190
- 29 For a license to operate a barber school or barber college, annual fee—not more
30 than500
- 31 For shop inspection, and annual license fee—not more than~~40~~50
- 32 For restoration of expired shop license, if expiration period is under three years,
33 the lapsed fee
34 plus a restoration fee of not more than80
- 35 For a new shop, relocation or change of ownership—not more than~~80~~100
- 36 *For issuance of new chair lease license or annual renewal thereof—not more*

1 *than*.....50

2 *For restoration of expired chair lease license, if expiration period is under three*

3 *years, the lapsed fees*

4 *plus a restoration fee of not more than*.....50

5 For issuance of a seminar permit—not more than80

6 For issuance of student learning license—not more than~~55~~65

8 (c) A duplicate license will be issued upon the filing of a statement

9 covering the loss of same and the payment of a fee of \$5 for the issuance

10 of same. Each duplicate shall have the word "duplicate" stamped across

11 the face thereof and will bear the same number as the original.

12 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 65-1817 is hereby repealed.

13 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

14 publication in the statute book.
