1 AN ACT concerning covered offenses and conduct giving rise to
2 forfeiture; relating to fleeing or eluding; amending K.S.A. 2011 Supp.
3 60-4104 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 60-4104 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 60-4104. Conduct and offenses giving rise to forfeiture under this
8 act, whether or not there is a prosecution or conviction related to the
9 offense, are:

10 (a) All offenses which statutorily and specifically authorize forfeiture;
11 (b) violations of K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5701 through 21-5717, and
12 amendments thereto;

13 (c) theft, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5801, and amendments thereto;

14 (d) criminal discharge of a firearm, as defined in subsections (a)(1)
15 and (a)(2) of K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-6308, and amendments thereto;

16 (e) gambling, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-6404, and amendments thereto,
17 and commercial gambling, as defined in subsection (a)(1) of K.S.A. 2011
18 Supp. 21-6406, and amendments thereto;

19 (f) counterfeiting, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5825, and amendments
20 thereto;

21 (g) violations of K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-6108, and amendments
22 thereto;

23 (h) medicaid fraud, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5925 through 21-5934, and
24 amendments thereto;

25 (i) an act or omission occurring outside this state, which would be a
26 violation in the place of occurrence and would be described in this section
27 if the act occurred in this state, whether or not it is prosecuted in any state;

28 (j) an act or omission committed in furtherance of any act or omission
29 described in this section including any inchoate or preparatory offense,
30 whether or not there is a prosecution or conviction related to the act or
31 omission;

32 (k) any solicitation or conspiracy to commit any act or omission
33 described in this section, whether or not there is a prosecution or
34 conviction related to the act or omission;

35 (l) violations of K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5423, and amendments
36 thereto;

1 (m) unlawful conduct of dog fighting and unlawful possession of dog
2 fighting paraphernalia, as defined in subsections (a) and (b) of K.S.A.
3 2011 Supp. 21-6414, and amendments thereto;

4 (n) unlawful conduct of cockfighting and unlawful possession of
5 cockfighting paraphernalia, as defined in subsections (a) and (b) of K.S.A.
6 2011 Supp. 21-6417, and amendments thereto;

7 (o) prostitution, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-6419, and amendments
8 thereto, promoting prostitution, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-6420, and
9 amendments thereto, and patronizing a prostitute, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-
10 6421, and amendments thereto;

11 (p) human trafficking and aggravated human trafficking, K.S.A. 2011
12 Supp. 21-5426, and amendments thereto;

13 (q) violations of K.S.A. 9-2012, and amendments thereto;

14 (r) mistreatment of a dependent adult, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5417,
15 and amendments thereto;

16 (s) giving a worthless check, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5821, and
17 amendments thereto;

18 (t) forgery, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5823, and amendments thereto;

19 (u) making false information, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5824, and
20 amendments thereto;

21 (v) criminal use of a financial card, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5828, and
22 amendments thereto;

23 (w) violations of K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5839, and amendments
24 thereto;

25 (x) identity theft and identity fraud, as defined in subsections (a) and
26 (b) of K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-6107, and amendments thereto; ~~and~~

27 (y) electronic solicitation, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 21-5509, and
28 amendments thereto; *and*

29 (z) *felony violations of K.S.A. 8-1568, and amendments thereto.*

30 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 60-4104 is hereby repealed.

31 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
32 publication in the statute book.
