By Legislative Educational Planning Committee

1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas private and out-of-state postsecondary
2 educational institution act; relating to fees; amending K.S.A. 2010
3 Supp. 74-32,181 and repealing the existing section; also repealing
4 K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-32,181a.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-32,181 is hereby amended to read
8 as follows: 74-32,181. (a) This section is subject to the provisions of
9 K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-32,181a, and amendments thereto.

10 (b) (a) The state board shall fix, charge and collect fees for
11 certificates of approval, registration of representatives and providing
12 transcripts to students who attended an institution that has ceased
13 operation not to exceed the following amounts by adopting rules and
14 regulations for such purposes, subject to the following limitations:

15 (1) For institutions domiciled or having their principal place of
16 business within the state of Kansas:

17 Initial issuance of certificate of approval nondegree granting — not more
18 than.....\$1,700

19 Initial issuance of certificate of approval degree granting — not more
20 than.....\$2,000

21 Renewal of certificate of approval nondegree granting — not more than
22 .....\$1,200

23 Renewal of certificate of approval degree granting — not more than
24 .....\$1,600

25 Initial registration of representative — not more than.....\$150

26 Annual renewal of registration of representative — not more than.....\$100

28 Non-degree granting institution.....\$2,000

29 Degree granting institution.....\$3,000

43	(d) (c) If there is a change in the ownership of an institution and, if	

1 at the same time, there also are changes in the institution's programs of  
2 instruction, location, entrance requirements or other changes, the  
3 institution shall be required to submit an application for an initial  
4 certificate of approval and shall pay all applicable fees associated with an  
5 initial application.

6 ~~(e)~~ (d) An application for renewal shall be deemed late if the  
7 applicant fails to submit a completed application for renewal, or  
8 documentation requested by the state board to complete the renewal  
9 process, before the expiration date of the current certificate of approval.

10 ~~(f)~~ (e) The state board shall determine on or before June 1 of each  
11 year the amount of revenue which will be required to properly carry out  
12 and enforce the provisions of the Kansas private and out-of-state  
13 postsecondary educational institution act for the next ensuing fiscal year  
14 and shall fix the fees authorized for such year at the sum deemed  
15 necessary for such purposes within the limits of this section. Prior to  
16 adoption of any such fees, the state board shall afford the advisory  
17 commission an opportunity to make recommendations on the proposed  
18 fees.

19 ~~(g)~~ (f) Fees may be charged to conduct onsite reviews for degree  
20 granting and non-degree granting institutions or to review curriculum in  
21 content areas where the state board does not have expertise.

22 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-32,181 and 74-32,181a are hereby  
23 repealed.

25 publication in the statute book.
