SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2230

As Recommended by House Committee on
Government Efficiency

Brief*

HB 2230 would repeal the statute establishing the Frontier Military Scenic Byway.

Background

The bill was requested and supported in testimony by the Chairperson of the Frontier Military Scenic Byway Committee. By repealing the current statutory authority, the byway could be placed under the Kansas Byways Program and then the name could be changed to the Frontier Military Historic Byway. The change in name also would assist in applying for federal aid awarded as grants to historic byway projects, according to a representative of the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) who supported the action to allow the byway to be re-designated in the Kansas Byways Program as the Frontier Military Historic Byway. The Kansas Byways Program is administered by KDOT.

No one appeared in opposition to the bill.

The fiscal note indicated that KDOT could absorb any expenditures for signage within its existing FY 2012 resources for the Kansas Byways Program.
