**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2390**

As Amended by House Committee on  
General Government Budget

**Brief\***

HB 2390, as amended by the House General Government Budget Committee, would eliminate KAN-ED effective July 1, 2012. In addition, the bill would abolish the KAN-ED Fund and transfers all moneys and liabilities of the Fund to the State General Fund on July 1, 2012. Finally, the bill would eliminate provisions transferring funding from the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) to the KAN-ED Fund.

**Background**

Proponents of the bill included representatives from Verizon Wireless, Kansas Cable Telecommunications Association, and the executive director of the Center for Applied Economics at the University of Kansas School of Business. Opponents of the bill included representatives of the Board of Regents, the Kansas Hospital Association, and various hospitals, school districts, and public libraries.

The Budget Committee amended the provisions of the bill to change the date of elimination of KAN-ED, its related funds, and funding from July 1, 2011 to July 1, 2012.
