

MINUTES OF THE HOUSE FEDERAL & STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Without objection, Representative Pauls introduced **HB 3041 - Kansas council for interstate adult offender supervision; membership, duties.** Representative Pauls provided the committee details why this supplemental legislation is necessary to join the companion legislation passed earlier in session if at least 35 states pass the compact during the interim. She stated this is necessary to provide selection of council membership of the council and inasmuch as the original legislation was noncontroversial, she stated she expected no opposition to this legislation.

Chairman Mays requested the committee consider **SB 74 - Native American tribal law enforcement officers.**
Representative Cox made a motion to remove the present language and replace with language in House Sub. SB 74 returning the filing deadline to June 10 with the exclusion of Congressional offices. Representative Benlon seconded the motion. The motion carried with Representative Wilson requesting to be recorded in opposition.

Chairman Mays requested the committee consider **SB 152 - Alcoholic beverages; furnishing to minors; licensees; ABC, director.**
Representative Powell made a motion to remove the present language and replace with language in House Sub. SB 152 regarding the Congressional redistricting. Representative Ruff seconded the motion. The motion passed.
