Insight School of Kansas is a charter of the Springhill School District in Olathe, Kansas.

Insight School of Kansas uses Aventa curriculum.

Insight School of Kansas serves students in grades 7-12, in addition to serving adult learners, during the 2012-2013 school year.

Insight School of Kansas serves students throughout the state of Kansas.

As of January 2013, Insight School of Kansas has 440 enrolled students.

The Insight program includes full service academic programs and provides the continuum of services to students.

Insight School of Kansas provides instruction to students with 28 regular education teachers, 6 advisors, a social worker, two counselors and one special education teacher. All teachers and advisors participate in a two week virtual training program and one day of in-person training prior to the start of school. Teachers participate in weekly staff meetings, monthly National Professional Development with K12 and quarterly school-based professional development throughout the school year.

Insight School of Kansas supports faculty and families with a Head of School, High School Director, Operations Manager, and Registrar.

Teachers work with our advisors to schedule monthly field trips and activities for families.

Insight School of Kansas hosts several virtual clubs locally and holds to large annual events, such as Fall Festival and Prom.

Insight hosts annual graduation ceremonies. Last year's graduating class totaled 102 graduates. Insight hosted 800 family, friends and educators at the graduation ceremony.
