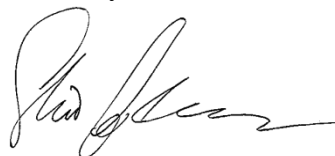
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 122 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 122 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 122 would amend the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, by allowing service of an order or notice to be made electronically if agreed upon by the parties.

The Department of Administration indicates electronic delivery of service of an order or notice could reduce expenses associated with mailing or personal delivery; however, the agency is unable to estimate a precise fiscal effect. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 122 is not reflected in *The FY 2014 Governor's Budget Report*.
