Subject: Working After Retirement - UPDATED

School Districts

The working after retirement participants in Kansas school districts in 2011 (latest information available) totaled 2,503 retirees. Active KPERS membership from the school districts totaled 73,809. Using those numbers, KPERS calculated the proportion of working after retirement participants at 3.4 percent of the total active KPERS membership at the school districts. Generally, smaller school districts (as measured by number of active KPERS members) utilized WAR participants at a higher rate than larger districts.

Splitting the school districts into thirds based on number of active KPERS members shows the difference in the utilization of working after retirement participants in 2011. Attachment A is a chart showing the difference in the number of active KPERS members and the percent of working after retirement participants as a proportion of active KPERS members. The chart shows that, when arrayed by number of active members, the top third of districts (i.e., the largest districts) vastly outpace the lower two-thirds of districts in total number of active KPERS members. However, the utilization of working after retirement participants in the bottom third of districts (i.e., the smallest districts) was more than double the utilization in the largest districts (6.4 percent v. 2.9 percent). The middle third of districts (i.e., medium-sized districts) utilized working after retirement participants at a rate about 1.8 times more than the largest districts (5.3 percent v. 2.9 percent).

Utilizing geographic information obtained from the Kansas State Department of Education website, we separated the number of working after retirement participants by county. There was no single geographic region of Kansas that showed a clearly higher school district utilization of working after retirement participants. Attachment B shows a map of Kansas counties colored by the school district working after retirement utilization.

The central office location of the top ten percent of districts utilizing working after retirement participants can be found in Attachment C. All of the districts on the map have utilization rates greater than 10.0 percent.



A table of all school districts and their active KPERS members, working after retirement participants, utilization rate, and central office location sorted by working after retirement utilization can be found in Attachment D.

Attachment E sorts the school districts by district number and distinguishes between retirees returning to work for their former employer or a different employer. However, it does not break out retirees returning under the special working after retirement exemptions for licensed professional school employees.

KPERS cannot evaluate the specific type of positions being filled by working after retirement participants – e.g., biology teachers or special education teachers. While it appears that utilization of working after retirement participants is relatively evenly spread around the state, it could also be true that counties in the less populated, western Kansas counties are hiring harder to fill positions out of a lack of qualified teachers in that area. KPERS does not track member information to that level of detail.

Other Employers

The school districts in Kansas employed approximately 63 percent of the working after retirement participants in 2011. The remaining 37 percent or 1,462 working after retirement participants were employed by 320 employers. The participants were employed by

- 61 state agencies (counted as a single employer);
- 273 local units of government; and
- 46 non-K-12 school group employers, mostly community and technical colleges, and education co-operatives.

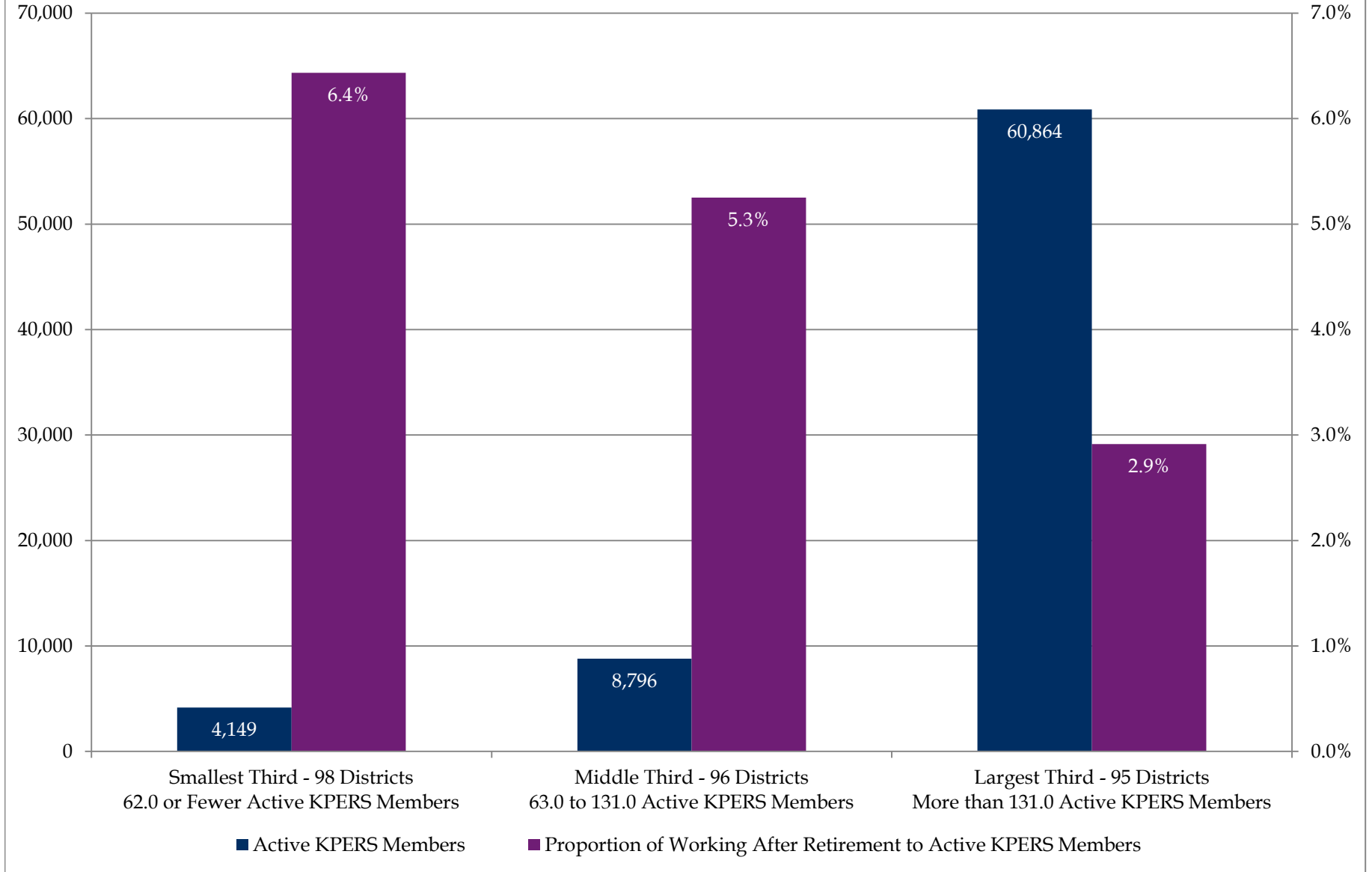
Overall, 64.1 percent of working after retirement participants not employed by school districts were rehired by the same employer the participant worked for prior to retirement, 34.7 percent worked for a different employer, and the remaining 1.2 percent were licensed state nurses. The licensed state nurses who retire and subsequently return to work for certain state institutions are exempt from the working after retirement statutes, similar to the exemptions made for licensed teachers returning to work after retirement.

Working after retirement participants in the State group were most likely to work for the same employer, likely due to the fact that all state agencies are counted as a single employer. Attachment F shows the employers who employed working after retirement participants in 2011, organized by membership group and then alphabetically by agency name.

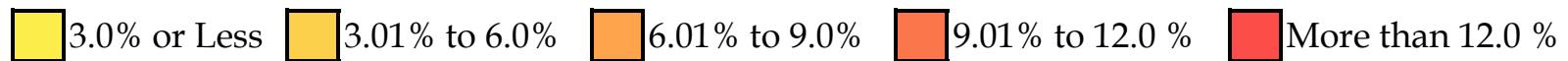
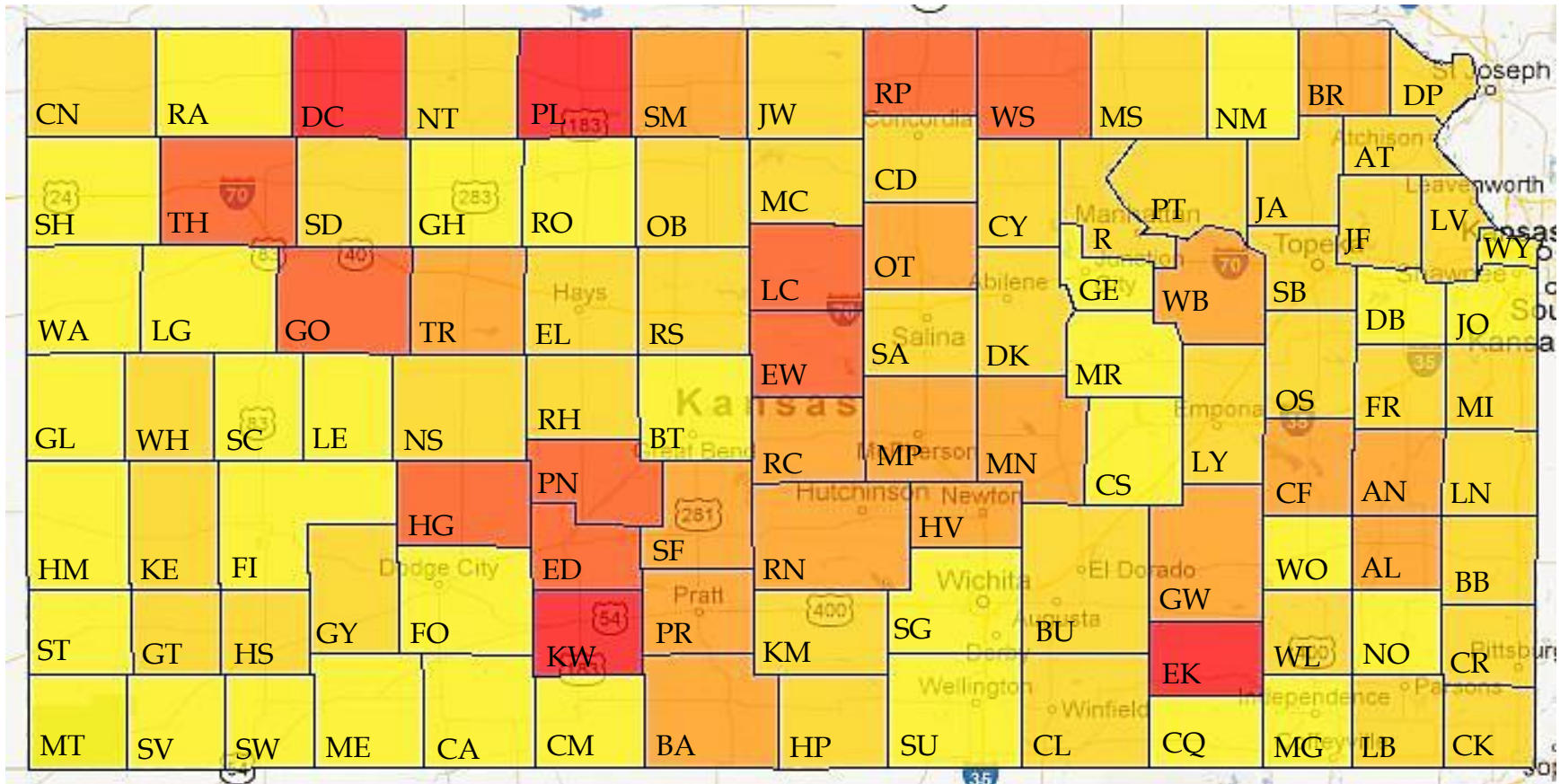
