

**TESTIMONY BEFORE
HOUSE TAXATION COMMITTEE**

**REGARDING HOUSE BILL 2136
RELATING TO TAX**

February 14, 2013

Mr. Chairman and Committee Members:

I am Mike King, Secretary for the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT). House Bill 2136 will prevent KDOT from delivering the Transportation Works for Kansas (T-WORKS) Program as promised.

One of KDOT's key roles is to advocate for the transportation needs of Kansans. Transportation is a very important component of economic development and job creation in Kansas. This is a top priority for the administration and as such, is included in the Governor's Roadmap for Kansas.

The T-WORKS program promises investment in infrastructure that would provide over \$10 billion in economic impact and thousands of jobs to the state of Kansas, in addition to safety, maintenance and other modal investments. Although we have several revenue sources that provide the funding for the program, 28% of the funding comes from sales taxes. Reducing the amount of sales tax available for the program, as this bill proposes, will prevent the department from completing the program.

HB 2136 would reduce KDOT's anticipated revenues by \$1.5 billion over the course of the T-WORKS program. Put simply, KDOT will not be able to deliver the projects that Kansas communities are depending on. Please see the attached list of projects that will be impacted should the program not be completed. This list represents highway projects that are currently programmed to be let in or after 2014.

Thank you for allowing me to speak to HB 2136. I would be happy to stand for questions at the appropriate time.
