#### **Agency Request**

The **agency** requests \$12.9 million for building projects for FY 2014. The request includes \$9.5 million for rehabilitation and repair projects and \$3.4 million for general rehabilitation and repair.

#### Governor's Recommendation

The **Governor** recommends \$6.1 million for building projects for FY 2014, a decrease of \$6.8 million below the agency's request. The Governor concurs with the agency's request for rehabilitation and repair, re-roofing various buildings, subarea modernization projects, and

remote chemical storage bunkers, but does not recommend the remainder of the agency's request.
