1 AN ACT concerning the use of state appropriated moneys.

2 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

3 Section 1. (a) No portion of any money appropriated by the state
4 legislature shall be used, other than for normal and recognized executive
5 and legislative relationships, for publicity or propaganda purposes, for the
6 preparation, distribution or use of any kit, pamphlet, booklet, publication,
7 electronic communication, radio, television or video presentation designed
8 to support or defeat the enactment of legislation before the state legislature
9 or a local government legislative body or designed to support or defeat any
10 proposed or pending regulation, administrative action, or order issued by
11 any state agency or local government.

12 (b) No portion of any appropriation shall be used to pay the salary or
13 expenses of any grant or contract recipient, or agent acting on behalf of
14 such recipient, related to any activity designed to influence the enactment
15 of legislation, an appropriation, a regulation, an administrative action, or
16 an executive order proposed or pending before the Kansas legislature or
17 local government legislative body.

18 (c) The prohibitions in subsection (a) and (b) shall include any
19 activity to advocate or promote any proposed, pending or future federal,
20 state or local tax increase, or any proposed, pending, or future requirement
21 or restriction on any legal consumer product, including its sale or
22 marketing, ~~including, but not limited to,~~ the advocacy or promotion of gun
23 control.
