AN ACT concerning alcoholic beverages; relating to the employment of

certain individuals by licensees under the club and drinking establishment act; amending K.S.A. 41-2610 and repealing the existing

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 41-2610 is hereby amended to read as follows: 41-2610. It shall be unlawful for any licensee or holder of a temporary permit under this act to:

(a) Employ any person under the age of 18 years in connection with the serving of alcoholic liquor.

(b) Employ knowingly or continue in employment any person in connection with the dispensing or serving of alcoholic liquor or the mixing of drinks containing alcoholic liquor who has been adjudged guilty of a felony or of any crime involving a morals charge in this or any other state, or of the United States.

(c) Employ knowingly or to continue in employment any person in connection with the dispensing or serving of alcoholic liquor or mixing of drinks containing alcoholic liquor who has been adjudged guilty of a violation of any intoxicating liquor law of this or any other state, or of the United States, during the two year period immediately following such adjudging:

(b) Knowingly employ or continue to employ any person in connection with the dispensing or serving of alcoholic liquor, or mixing of drinks containing alcoholic liquor, who has been convicted of a person felony or a drug felony, or who is an offender as defined in K.S.A. 22-4902, and amendments thereto.

(c) Knowingly employ or continue to employ any person in connection with the dispensing or serving of alcoholic liquor, or the mixing of drinks containing alcoholic liquor, who has been adjudged guilty of three or more violutions of any intexicating liquor law of this or any other state, or of the United States, within the immediately preceding

thre years.

(d) In the case of a club, fail to maintain at the licensed premises a current list of all members and their residence addresses or refuse to allow
