My name is Scott Heidner, and I serve as the Executive Director of the American Council of Engineering Companies of Kansas (ACEC Kansas). ACEC Kansas is the trade association representing private engineering businesses in Kansas.

ACEC Kansas is supportive of SB 42. Currently, there is a strong disincentive for licensed professional engineers to offer their services on a voluntary basis. Barring specific statutory protection from liability, the risk is simply too high, and quite often uninsurable as well.

SB 42 would not only offer liability protection for volunteer design work done by licensed professional engineers in specific instances, it would also benefit Kansas schools by allowing them to harness the skills of these officials at no charge. In times of tight budgets, this is a true win-win.
