1 AN ACT concerning jurors; relating to information disqualifying juror
2 from jury service.

3 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

4 Section 1. (a) On and after July 1, 2013, any jury commissioner that
5 receives information regarding citizenship from a prospective juror or
6 court of this state that disqualifies or potentially disqualifies such
7 prospective juror from jury service pursuant to K.S.A. 43-156, and
8 amendments thereto, shall submit such information to the secretary of state
9 in a form and manner approved by the secretary of state in a form and
10 manner approved by the secretary of state and as established by
11 supreme court rule. Any such information provided by a jury
12 commissioner to the secretary of state shall be used for the purpose of
13 maintaining voter registrations as required by law and any other lawful
14 purpose.

15 (b) This section shall be part of and supplemental to article 1 of
16 chapter 43 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto.
