

- Correction Orders
- Civil Money Penalties

- Licensure Revocation



Medicaid and Medicare Certification

- ICF/IID may receive certification for Medicaid reimbursement.
- for Medicaid, Medicare, or both Nursing homes may receive certification
- only. "licensed only" and subject to state law Other adult care homes are considered

Medicaid and Medicare Certification

- Additional federal regulations and processes apply as prescribed by CMS.
- activities CMS contracts with states to conduct certification
- are very detailed and prescriptive. Regulations, interpretations, and survey protocols
- Enforcement remedies are imposed by CMS, with consultation from the state
