Chairman Petersen and members of the committee,

My name is Kelly Law. I am the Director of Membership and Marketing for the K-State Alumni Association.

Today I am representing the K-State Alumni Association in support of HB 2011. We have consulted the Kansas Association of County Treasurers and the universities and colleges who have educational license plate programs and they support HB 2011 as well.

This legislation would make the following changes to HB 2011: In addition to passenger vehicles and trucks not more than 20,000 pounds, education institutions would be allowed to offer motorcycle plates with their affinity logo.

The Pet Friendly and Fire Fighter program make plates available for motorcycles. Adding the ability to offer motorcycle tags would increase financial support to each institution through the donation amount that is required to purchase the tag.
