- ➤ Governor Brownback signed ERO 42 on Friday, January 19, which starts the 60-day clock
- ➤ Effective date of consolidation will be the beginning of Fiscal Year 2014 (July 1, 2013)
- ➤ ERO 42 purpose is to improve the quality of juvenile corrections

- Security audits led by Secretary Roberts & other KDOC staff
  - ➤ NO placing of juveniles within adult facilities
